- Have different sets of definitions and rules.
- Use mysterious internal jargon for names.
- Use multiple definitions for items of the same type.
- Require users to search around for extra documentation in order to understand the one at which they're already looking.
- Invent new definitions ad hoc.

Do:

- Have one set of definitions and rules.
- Use descriptive plain English names.
- Use one definition for items of the same type.
- Make everything understandable in its own right.
- Force compliance with the data dictionary.
